

The KGL Contest English Olympiad is a global competition for school students who are non-native speakers of English. The competition aims to measure students' proficiency in English skills (grammar, listening, vocabulary, reading, and writing) according to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR). Students aged 8 to 17 from all nationalities can participate in the KGL Contest.



KGLObjectives

Encourage students to participate in international competitions in an enjoyable way.



Prepare students to achieve global rankings.



Provide an opportunity for students to compete and assess their level locally and internationally.



Serve as an indicator of schools' commitment to excellence in English language education.





The competition consists of five levels. Students are placed at a level based on their proficiency and age, according to the CEFR. Students should consult with their teachers regarding the appropriate level for them, as levels cannot be changed once registration closes.

- The competition is held annually with two national (local) stages. The top 30% of participants from the first stage qualify for the second stage.
- Each stage includes a standardized test conducted locally in the city where the student resides and is coordinated through assigned centres (schools).
- The first-place winner from Stage 2 at each level qualifies for the global event, representing Saudi Arabia in an international competition hosted in Greece. This final stage brings students from various countries together for a global test.
- Participants who qualify for the global event enjoy a fully funded three-day experience, which includes travel, accommodation, local transportation, meals, and sightseeing tours.

*Students who achieve first place in levels A1, A2, B1, and B2 qualify to participate in the international event in Greece.


